

Hepatitis C virus (HCV) genotyping result	Interpretation	Resolution test (reflex test) performed?
1a, 2 (any 2 genotypes)	Result may be due to mixed genotype infection, recombination of HCV genotypes, or assay probe cross-reactivity.	No
1, 3 (2 genotypes with a 1 no subtype)	Result may be due to mixed genotype infection, recombination of HCV genotypes, or assay probe cross-reactivity. Resolution testing ordered.	Yes
HCV not detected	Assay failed to detect HCV RNA.	No
Indeterminate (undetermined genotype)	HCV RNA detected, but genotype could not be determined. Resolution testing ordered.	Yes
Indeterminate (mix)	Result may be due to mixed genotype infection, recombination of HCV genotypes, or assay probe cross-reactivity.	No

An "Undetected" result indicates the absence of detectable hepatitis C virus (HCV) RNA in the specimen.
